Vin d'Oeillades 2015

Oeillades is an old grape variety from the Languedoc, a close cousin to Cinsault. Thierry's Oeillades is a wine to drink young, fresh, on its fruits and spices. It is a wine to share without restraint (only 11,5% alcohol!) with friends.

Appellation:	Vin de France
Soils:	South-east facing slate hillsides (Brown schist).
Varieties:	Oeillade
Yield:	25 hl/ha
Production:	2,000 bottles
Viticulture:	Organic farming. Work in the vineyards. Use of herb preparations. Selective picking in the vineyard and at the winery. Manual harvest in small cagettes.
Vinification&ageing:	No destemming. Carbonic maceration for 8 days. Ageing in cement vats for 6 months. No oak.
Alcohol (%vol):	12
Total acidity (gH₂SO₄/l):	3,13
PH:	3,57
Total SO₂ (mg/l):	39
Tasting:	Camphor, myrtle and other scrubland aromas are jumping out of the glass. Big red fruits flavour hit with some liquorice. The tannins are soft; the wine is juicy, very refreshing.
Ideal with:	At the start of a meal, cold cuts, chicken, grilled meats.
