Nikolas and Carolin Bantlin's love of Jim Morrison inspired the name of this cuvee. Cool Moon is a delicious white wine from old vine Grenache Gris and Grenache blanc. It's a beautifully well-balanced wine perfect for the summer!

| Varieties: | 50% Grenache blanc, 50% Grenache gris |

| Viticulture: | Biodynamic farming. Short pruning (Gobelet pruning). Manual ploughing, debudding, pruning. Hand harvest. |
| Vinification&ageing: | Direct pressing. Fermentation with indigenous yeast in used barrels. Ageing in aged barrels on lees for 9 months. |
| Alcohol (%vol): | 12,5 |
| Total acidity (gH₂SO₄/l): | 4,34 |
| PH: | 3,05 |
| Total SO2 (mg/l): | 37 |
| Tasting: | It has a beautiful light yellow colour, with flavours of mandarin citrus, apple and fresh herbs. On the palate the wine is well balanced between some fatness and a great acidity backbone. Notes of lychee fruits are easily recognizable. The finish is spicy and salty. |
| Ideal with: | Poultry, spicy Asian cuisine, cheeses. |
